All movers must make a moving appointment with the Board's appointed property manager at least 7 days in advance to bwpov@condohood.com. Moving without an approved appointment carries a \$100.00 fine (billed to the owner). All movers are charged a \$25.00 non-refundable fee.

Dogs...
